The Orange Beach Correction Center is a self-contained thirty one bed, state of the art facility designed to hold misdemeanor prisoners for up to a year. The facility is also designed to house officers in the event of a hurricane or natural disaster.

## **Visitation**

Visitation is on Wednesday's from 1:30 pm to 4:30 pm and Sunday's from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Visitors will need to bring a picture ID. Children will be admitted with an adult only. We have a limited visiting area so please try to be flexible. Please call 251 981 9777 and make an appointment if possible, this will reduce the possible wait time for your visit. If you have a special need or handicap please call in advance, so we can make arrangements for you.

### **Phone privileges**

Inmates are allowed to use the collect call phones in the cellblock as spelled out in the inmate rules. We do not take messages for inmates except in the case of an emergency. The company currently providing our inmate phone service has a number of services they provide to make it easier for you to use the phone service. They are as follows, Advance connect (prepaid collect), Direct connect (a direct bill option) and Collect connect (charges are billed through your local phone company). Attached is a copy of the guidelines from Correctional Billing Services, they should be able to answer your questions about the inmate phones.

### **Work Release**

All sentenced inmates will receive an INMATE COMMITMENT INFO SHEET, which will have their fines, days to serve, and if and when they are eligible for work release or compensated trusty status. All inmates who qualify for trusty status may make application for trusty, this may be done after the waiting period noted on their commitment order. Inmates who have violated any jail rules or have been a discipline problem will not be allowed work release.

### **Information on jail sentence and fines**
