Examples include homicides, sexual assaults, robberies, arsons, identity thefts and fraud. Detectives have many investigative specialties and a high level of training and experience. The division includes a Detective Lieutenant, Sergeant and two general case detectives.

Juvenile Services Section/D.A.R.E.

The Juvenile Services Section/D.A.R.E. consists of one School Resource Officer (SRO). The SRO works hard to bridge gaps between police officers and young people, helping to increase positive attitudes towards law enforcement.

The SRO is assigned to the Orange Beach Elementary School and splits time between Orange Beach Elementary and Gulf Shores High School, where the SRO assists bi-weekly with the instruction of a forensics class. During the summer months, the officer is busy preparing for the next school year, working on special projects such as National Night Out, and assisting the detective division.

The SRO program provides:

- * Visible, active, law enforcement figures on school campuses, dealing with law enforcement related issues.
- * Classroom resources for instruction in law enforcement related education, violence diffusion, safety programs, and alcohol and drug prevention.
- * A team approach of officers, faculty and administration working together to solve problems in the school community.
- * Credible resources for the students, teachers and parents.
- * A safer school environment.
